


Manure Management

The revised Manure Management Manual went into effect in October 2011. All farms generating/using manure must have a manure management plan. The Cameron and Elk County Conservation District can help you learn the new regulations and write your plan. The workshop will be held March 27, 2012, 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM, at the Elk Country Visitor Center, Benezette, PA.

Topics covered by the workshop will include the revised Manure Management Manual, Chapter 102 (Erosion and Sediment Control) updates, and using PAOneStop for your Manure Management Plan. Attendees will receive a copy of the updated Manure Management Manual. One-on-one assistance will be available in order for attendees to leave the workshop with a completed Manure Management Plan for their farm.



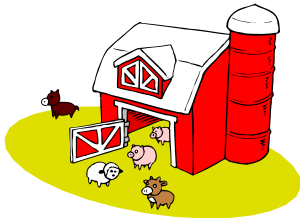

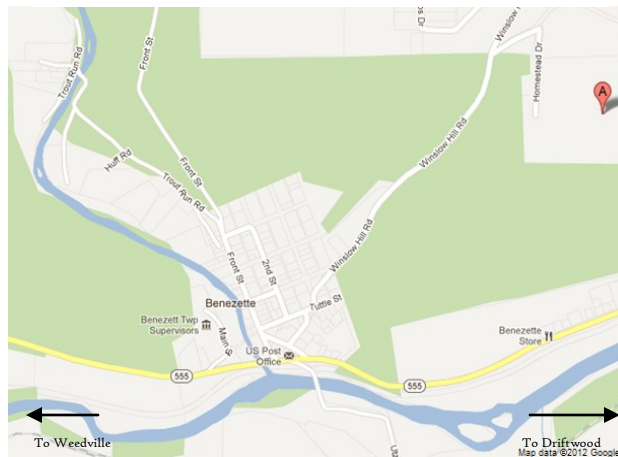


From St. Marys, PA

Take Route 255 South to the village of Weedville. Turn left onto Route 555 East. Take Route 555 East for 9 miles to the village of Benezette. In Benezette turn left onto Winslow Hill Road. Winslow Hill Road makes an S curve past the Benezette Hotel and the Church. Continue up the hill about quarter mile. The Elk Country Visitor Center entry located on the right, near our large sign.

From Emporium, PA

Take Route 120 East to Driftwood. Turn right onto Route 555 West. Take Route 555 West 16 miles to village of Benezette. In Benezette turn left onto Winslow Hill Road. Winslow Hill Road makes an S curve past the Benezette Hotel and the Church. Continue up the hill about quarter mile. The Elk Country Visitor Center entry
